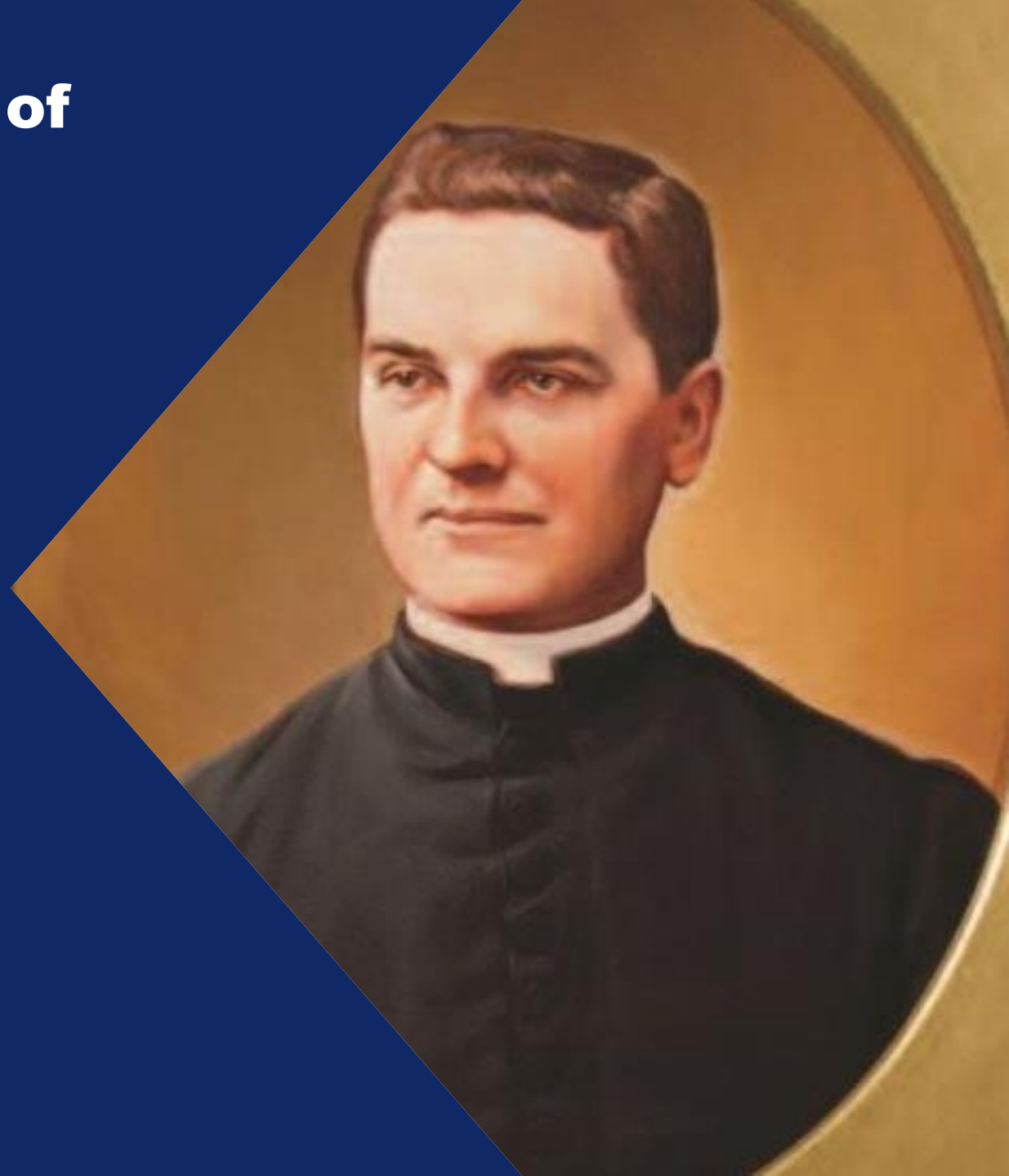

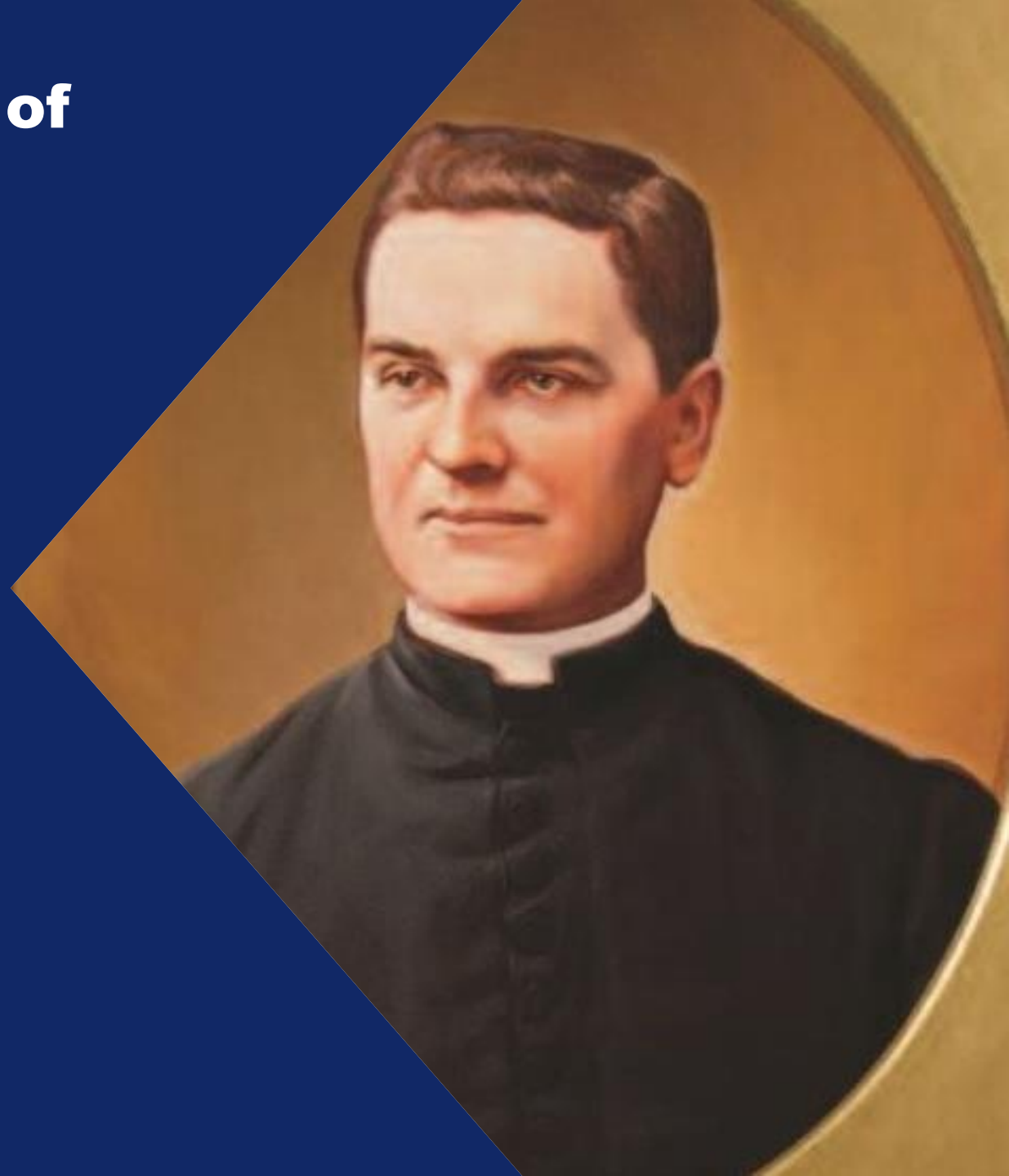
Prayer for the Canonization of Blessed Michael McGivney

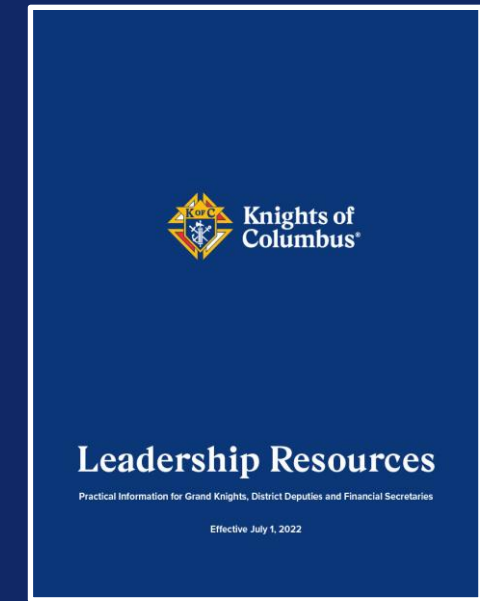
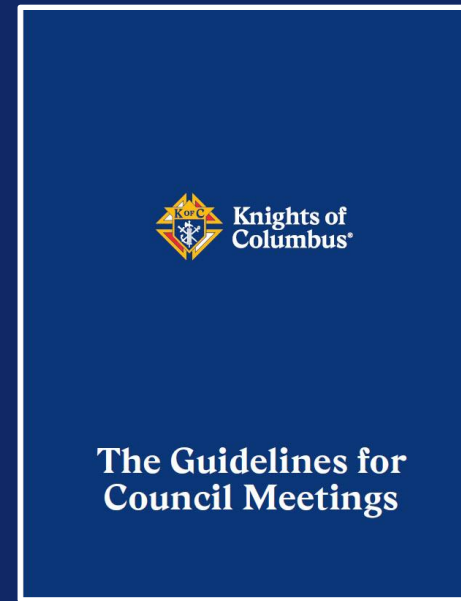

Knights in the 21st Century

- Evangelization and faith formation were key to Blessed Michael McGivney's vision for the Knights to keep men Catholic in the 19th Century

National Eucharistic Revival

- Three-year initiative sponsored by the U.S. bishops
 - **Mission:** To renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist
 - **Vision:** To inspire a movement of Catholics across the United States who are healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—and who are then sent out on mission “for the life of the world.”

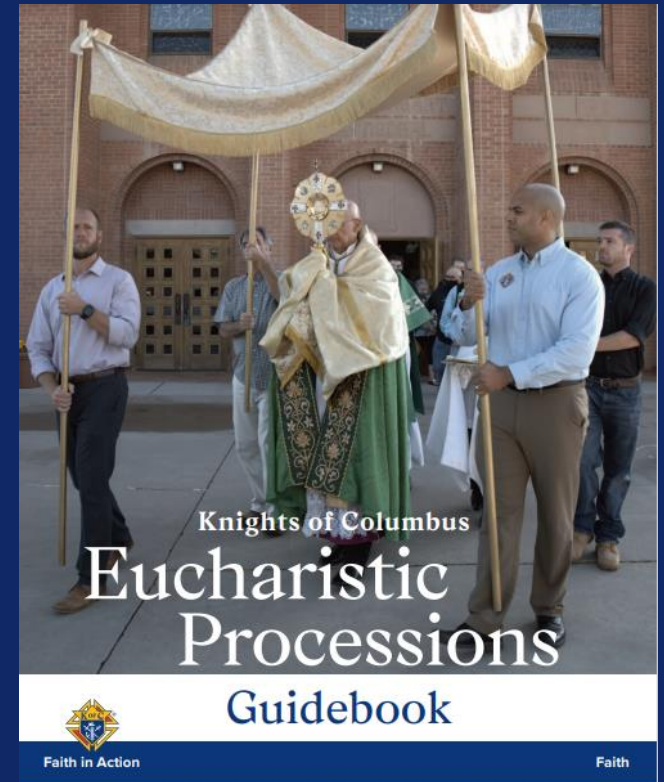

Catholic Demographic Trends

- Only 10% of practicing Catholics attend weekly mass
- Baptisms down 41.5% since 2000
- 20% of Baptized do not get first Communion
- 40% of Baptized do not get Confirmed
- 85% of Confirmed stop practicing by age 21
 - Decision is made by age 13
- Catholic marriages down 55% since 1990
